

PROSPECTUS

All items for sale must be made by you, the artist, and you must be present at the show to present your work unless there are approved exceptions.

All registration will be on the website where you will be asked to sign up, describe your craft, specify whether or not you require one of our tables and/or electricity and submit payment. Please provide a photo of your work that we may use for promotion of this event. Please send the image to me yreyes@graphicdesignworks.net.

There are 18 spaces available and exhibitors are accepted in the order the applications and payment are received with AOY Members given preferential acceptance. Location of exhibitors will be determined by an even distribution of crafts so that no one room is filled with too many of the same type craft. Help will be available to everyone during the setup hours of 4 to 7 pm on Friday, November 11 for carrying items from your vehicle to your location upstairs or on the main floor of the Janney House. Your table or setup may not be larger than 6 feet in length and 3 feet in depth. There is some flexibility in the placement of your display as long as you don't intrude on fellow artisans. This is a rain or shine event with no refund granted due to inclement weather.

You may take home precious, valuable art or crafts at night, but please leave your space set up. You must be ready to welcome guests at 10am on Saturday and Sunday and stay until 5pm, both days.

Our AOY event will again have the popular Chance Raffle Table displaying a required donation from each vendor with a minimum value of \$15. Raffle tickets will be sold and the proceeds will go toward the AOY Art Center capital improvements or funding for Art Scholarships. There will be a door prize to entice registration. Winners are called at 4pm on Sunday and recipients not present may make arrangements to pick up their winning items. We would like a small card with the artist's name and description of your donation to be placed by your work for our guests to read. You may place a stack of your own business cards there also.
